

ENTRY CONFIRMATION

Dear participants,

We are very pleased to receive and accept your entry for the 38th LKW FRIENDS on the road Jännerrallye powered by WIMBERGER.

You can find your assigned starting number online at <https://www.jaennerrallye.at/2025/nennliste.html>

The starting numbers were assigned to the best of our knowledge and belief and taking the previous results into account. As described in the regulations Art. 12.8, the start order on Friday, January 3rd, 2025 will be starting numbers reversed with a 2-minute gap for the entire field. On Saturday, January 4th, 2025 and Sunday, January 5th, 2025, the start will be based on the previous day's result, with the top 10 being reversed. The rally management will therefore only change the starting order on Friday, January 3rd, 2025 if there are good reasons (e.g. a change to the vehicle).

Roadbook Issuing

The roadbooks will be distributed in the **Freistadt exhibition hall at the information stand in Hall 1, Am Stieranger 10, 4240 Freistadt** in the following period:

Tuesday, December 31, 2024 from 19:00 to 20:00

Wednesday, 01.01.2025 from 10:00 to 20:00

Thursday, 02.01.2025 from 08:30 to 20:00

When the roadbook is issued, the registration number of the reconnaissance vehicle must be written down. If the entry fee has not been received in the organizer's account, the roadbook cannot be issued!

The roadbook is issued:

- roadbooks
- Sticker for recce vehicle
- Tracking system

deposit for GPS tracking system

When collecting the roadbook, a **deposit of EUR 200 in cash** is required for the tracking system.

Detailed information and instructions for the GPS system will be made available separately in Sportity before the Roadbook is issued. To mount the devices in the rally vehicle, a standard 1-inch ram mount ball is required, which must be permanently attached to the vehicle. This 1-inch ball can be purchased and installed by the teams themselves. Alternatively, such 1-inch ram mount balls can be purchased on site at the event.

Recce

The periods for inspecting all special stages and the shakedown are listed in Appendix II of the regulations. Each special stage may be driven **a maximum of 3 times**. **Checks are carried out using the GPS tracking system**. The rules and penalties according to Art. 35 of the current AMF Rallye Sporting Regulations apply.

We plan to organize the Jännerrallye again in subsequent years. We therefore ask you not to make a negative impression during recce and to obey the speed limits - on special stages and road sections alike. **Please note that not all residents and property owners are rally fans and even a single incident can become a problem for future permits.**

Service area

The service area is located on the exhibition grounds **around the Freistadt exhibition hall, Am Stieranger, 4240 Freistadt** and on the paved part of the **ÖTB site** opposite the Hotel Freigold and at **Stifterplatz (bus station)**.

The service area can be occupied from Thursday, January 2nd, 2024 at 12:00.

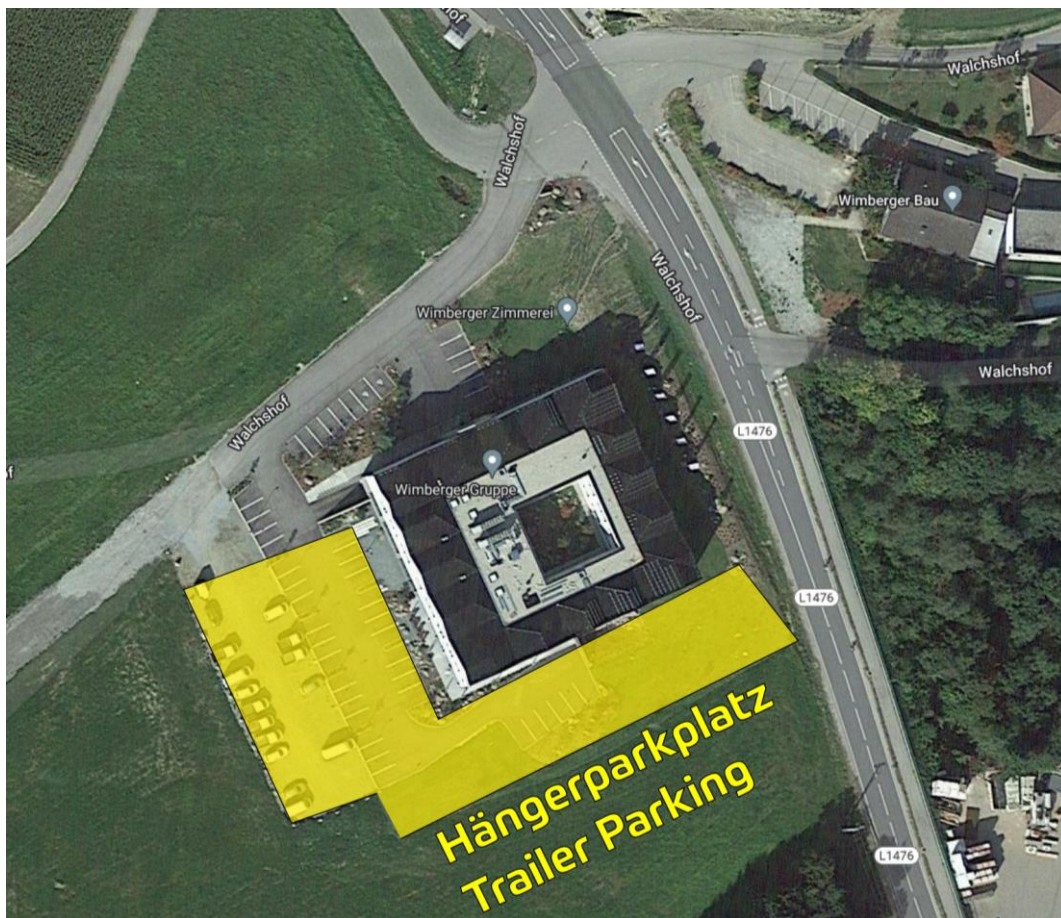
We ask for your understanding that only requests for service places submitted before the deadline could be considered and that the allocated areas must be strictly adhered to so that every team can get its place.

The traffic routes must be kept clear!

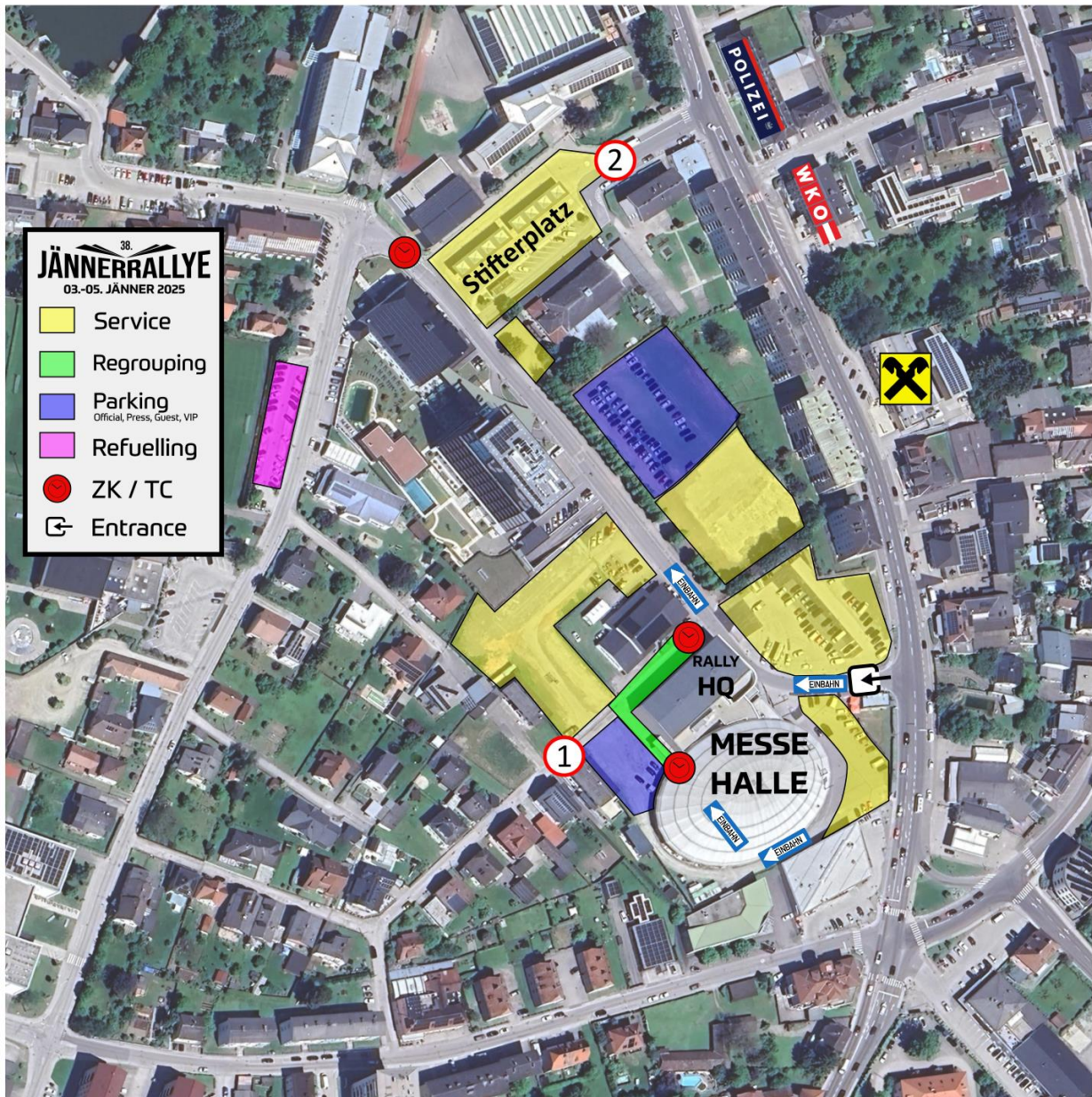
Recce and other vehicles must be parked in the designated parking lot (blue) on the ÖTB site.

Trailer parking

Due to limited space, trailers cannot be parked in the service area. Local teams are asked to park trailers at home. For teams traveling further, there is a trailer parking area on the WIMBERGER site, **WimbergerHof 1, 4291 Lasberg** :



If trailers are parked in the parking areas at the exhibition grounds on the rally days, they will be removed at your expense!



Walking speed is compulsory throughout the entire exhibition grounds!

Administrative scrutineering

Location: **Rally HQ, Hall 2, Am Stieranger 10, 4240 Freistadt**
Period: Thursday, 02.01.2025 from 09:00-19:00
Friday, 03.01.2025 from 08:00-14:00

Participants who do not book a time slot by January 1, 2025 will be assigned a time slot by the organization team. The booked time is binding. Registration at a different time may involve long waiting times.

The technical scrutineering is only possible after successful admin scrutineering! Therefore, book your admin scrutineering time before the technical scrutineering time!

The following documents must be submitted and will be checked:

- competitor license
- license (driver/co-driver)
- driver's license (driver)
- vehicle registration certificate (vehicle registration document)
- proof of insurance (liability insurance)
- Declaration of consent of the vehicle owner (*if the driver is not the owner of the vehicle*)
- Foreign start permit (*only applies to participants from abroad*)
- Additions and completion of the entry form
- Payment of service place deposit (€ 50,- in cash at admin. scrutineering)

Technical scrutineering

Period: Thursday, 02.01.2025 from 11:00-18:00
Friday, 03.01.2025 from 07:30-14:00

NO STUDED TIRES ARE ALLOWED DURING THE TECHNICAL SCRUTINEERING!

The following documents must be submitted and will be checked:

- homologation sheet (original)
- Certificate Safety Cell (Cage)
- Safety tank certificate (if required in vehicle category)
- AMF Wagenpass , AMF Wagenpass Historic , FIA HTP
- SOS/OK sign (DIN A3)

ATTENTION: due to the new FIA clothing regulations, all safety clothing must be presented at the technical inspection!

Licenses

Licenses can **no longer be applied for on site** at the administrative scrutineering, **only online directly at your ASN**. If a valid license cannot be presented, the entry fee will NOT be refunded!

Allowed tires

We would like to point out again the **tire limitation** during the competition: see regulations Art. 7. The tires used are carefully checked and recorded. After the TC Service OUT at the refueling zone, there is a separate tire inspection zone in which each participant is allowed to stand for 2 minutes. The times for the road sections have been calculated accordingly. There will be at least one check in each section.

Shakedown

Location: **Oberrauchenödt - Mitterbach**

Time: **Friday, January 3, 2025 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.**

Participation in the shakedown must be announced and paid for at the administrative inspection. The shakedown entry fee is €75 (included in the entry fee for Rally2, RRC and CKM participants). Participation in the shakedown is **only possible after successfully completing the admin and technical inspection**. We therefore recommend booking the time slots for the admin and technical inspection on Thursday, January 2nd, 2025. Shakedown time cards will be issued to registered teams at the admin inspection.

At the shakedown, 30-second start intervals are planned to allow for more rides. There is no limit to the number of rides per participant. We recommend using the opportunity for shakedown rides from 9:00 a.m. onwards. Experience has shown that many participants only want to ride at the end of the time, which can lead to

longer waiting times and, in the worst case, participants have to be sent away at 1:30 p.m. because the time has run out.

Passengers at the shakedown

Under certain conditions, it is possible to take other codrivers along as guests to the shakedown. The prerequisite is a liability waiver signed **personally by the codriver**. This can be done either at the Rally HQ or directly with the security personnel at the pre-start of the shakedown. After personally signing, drivers receive a non-transferable wristband.

Passenger wristbands will be checked at the pre-start shakedown!

Participants with a passenger without a wristband will not be allowed to start! There are **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS**. Please do not try to race without a wristband. Such attempts will delay the shakedown for all participants, as participants with a passenger without a wristband will have to wait, turn around or drive without a passenger!

There will be a space reserved for tire change and passenger change at the road section in the village Schlag near the commuter parking lot ([LINK](#)). Since space is limited there, we ask all teams not to park service vehicles there permanently and to keep the time spent on site as short as possible.

Photos for live stream

As in previous years, an extensive live stream is planned. To improve the live stream, we plan to display photos of the driver and passenger when they are shown in the stream.

We would like to ask all drivers and co-drivers to come to the livestream studio in Hall 2 in front of the green screen to take photos on Thursday, January 2nd, 2025 between 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

Please wear appropriate clothing: team clothing or overalls. Participants without appropriate clothing will be loaned a Jännerrallye jacket for the photo.

Driver briefing

Location: **Messehalle Freistadt, Am Stieranger 10, 4240 Freistadt**

Time: **Thursday, January 2, 2024 at 7:00 p.m.**

Drivers and/or co-drivers of a team are **obliged** to attend the drivers' meeting. Failure to attend will result in a fine of EUR 100. The presence of team members will be checked using an attendance list with signatures.

The drivers' briefing will begin at 7:00 p.m. in English and then again in German from around 7:20 p.m.

Following the drivers' briefing, there will be an **autograph session with 350 already registered children and young people from the youth fire brigade** in the rally region. We ask all participants to take the time for this and, if possible, to prepare enough autograph cards.
